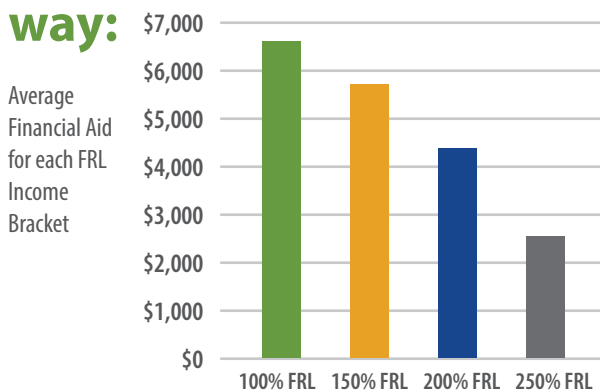
Your average out of pocket cost per student would be
