### **Placement Exam**

**Saturday, December 5, 2015: 9:00 am – 12:30 pm (preferred date)**

**Friday, January 15, 2016: 8:00 am – 11:30 am (make-up date)**

All incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students are required to take the High School Placement Test (HSPT) prior to admission to Marian.

### **School Visit**

**November – February**

Current 8<sup>th</sup> grade students in Marian partner schools will have a scheduled visit to Marian so that all students can shadow a current Marian student for the day. Students who are not currently enrolled in Marian partner schools can schedule a visit any time by contacting Mrs. Mary Kay Dance in the Office of Admissions at 574-259-5257.

### **Application Deadline and Acceptance Notification**

**Monday, February 29, 2016**

All material on the application checklist must be submitted to Marian in order for incoming students to be considered for admission. We highly encourage families to submit the application for admission well before the February 29<sup>th</sup> deadline. The applications will be reviewed immediately upon their receipt and students will then receive notification of Marian's decision regarding admission.

### **Registration by Appointment Only**

**Monday, March 7 – Friday, March 18, 2016**

Families will receive notification of the date and time to complete the registration process. Students and parents meet with Marian School Counselors and the Director of Admissions to register for classes.

### **Financial Aid/F.A.C.T.S. Grant and Aid Application Deadline**

**Wednesday, March 16**

Families will be informed of the financial aid awarded in May or early June.

In June, the party responsible for tuition and fee payment will receive a payment plan invite from F.A.C.T.S via email. At that time, an individual can choose from one of the three payment options listed below.

- **Option 1** – Pay the tuition and fees in full by submitting a check to Marian High School or by mailing a check to FACTS Management.
- **Option 2** – Pay ½ of the tuition and fees in July and the second ½ in December by choosing the split payment option on the FACTS website. There is a \$40 fee charged for choosing Option 2.
- **Option 3** – Divide the tuition and fees due over 11 months beginning in July. Payment will be directly debited from your checking/savings account on either the 5<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, or the last day of each month. There is a \$66 fee charged for choosing Option 3.
