



Marian High School and Mishawaka Catholic School, in a joint venture, are looking to hire four part-time child care providers to care for the children of our teachers and staff members during the school year. We are looking for two child care providers to work in the mornings, 7:15 AM-12:15 PM, and another two to work in the afternoons, 12-4 PM. Pay is \$12/hour.

Your day would include:

- Loving, rocking, feeding, changing, and playing with babies.
- Loving, teaching, entertaining, feeding and caring for toddlers.
- Tracking children's play, sleep, and nutrition throughout each day.
- Providing developmentally appropriate activities and play for each child.
- Working with and communicating with parents.
